

1978 Convention on the Conservation of Migratory Species of Wild Animals (Bonn Convention) Specially Protected Areas and Wildlife (SPAW)


Protocol of the Cartagena Convention

Inter-American Convention for the Protection and Conservation of Sea Turtles

Turtles are protected year round on St. Eustatius







Statia's role in sea turtle conservation

Goal: to promote the long term survival of the endangered sea turtles populations of Statia

- Monitor sea turtle nesting and foraging populations
- Protect habitat and reduce impacts on nesting populations
 - Conducting beach clean-ups
 - Limit impacts on nesting beaches (sand mining, erosion, driving)
- Involve the local community














Beach Mapping 10 years - ongoing









Leatherback Hatching Success History of low nesting success 2009 – pilot nest relocation project

- Hatching success in relocation area was 0%
- Use the shading method advised or ...









In-Water survey in 2008 and 2011

Survey is done around the entire island

Most sightings are on the Caribbean side of the island – the busiest side





In Water Dive Sightings

- Collaboration with the local dive shops to provide data of all sighted sea turtles in marine park
- **Started in 2005 and is ongoing**
- Size, sex, distribution, activity, environment, periods







Population assessment at Chien Tong Results from the G5 logger research continued in follow up population assessment study (40 turtles counted) Tagging Sea turtles with all-weather paint stick and the Lincoln-Petersen method will be used
