




Relation of aboitic conditions to hatch success for relocated hawksbill sea turtle, Eretmochelys imbricata, nests at Buck


















Previous In-water Sea Turtle Research at BIRNM – 1994-2004

- Juvenile Hawksbills feed primarily on zoanthids (Mayor 1998), while adults and subadults feed on sponges
- Hawksbill distribution is related to zoanthid cover (Pemberton 2000).











Adult hawksbill turtle Catch Per Unit Effort (CPUE) per survey block during surveys conducted in 2012.

Juvenile green turtle CPUE per survey block during surveys conducted in 2012.




